

New Venture Creations ID 210401 Level 2

The purpose of the NQF level 2 New Venture Creation qualification is to provide a qualification that can form the basis for structured programmes for potential and existing entrepreneurs to capitalise on opportunities to start and grow sustainable businesses that form part of the mainstream economy, enabling the learners to tender for business opportunities within both the public and private sectors. This qualification is designed for learners who intend to set up or have already set up own ventures. Assessment of the competencies and knowledge in the qualification needs to be done in the context of the learner's own new venture.

Office Administrator ID 102161 Level 5

This occupational qualification provides an opportunity for the learner to acquire a range of administrative skills to coordinate the activities of an office including information management and operational processes.

Training & Development Practitioner ID 101321 Level 5

The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a learner to operate as a Learning and Development Practitioner.

A Learning and Development Practitioner plans, writes learning objectives, selects and adapts learning resources required for the delivery of learning interventions, and facilitates learning in an occupational context.

Social Aux Worker ID 98890 Level 5

A social auxiliary worker works under the guidance and control of the social worker and as a supporting service to a social worker to achieve the aims of social work". This implies that social auxiliary workers are assistants to social workers, providing support services and working under the supervision of social workers. Social auxiliary work complements and supports social work in all focus areas with services to individuals, families, groups and communities.

Early Childhood Development ID 97542 Level 4

This course is aimed at preparing you to operate as an Early Childhood Development Practitioner in centre-based and non-centre-based early childhood development settings.

Occupational Health & Safety ID 99714 Level 5

The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a learner to operate as an Occupational Health and Safety Practitioner.

An Occupational Health and Safety Practitioner serves as a facilitator and advisor to employees and management regarding safety and health aspects in the workplace including the monitoring and inspecting of the workplace and the recording and investigation of incidents and accidents. They also implement and maintain Occupational Health and Safety systems to ensure a safe and healthy work environment.

Assessment Practitioner ID 220320 Level 5

An Assessment Practitioner plans for, conducts and administers assessment of learner competence in an occupational context.

Community Development Practitioner ID 97691 Level 5

The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a learner to operate as a Community Development Practitioner.

A Community Development Practitioner acts as a change agent to add value to community development practice by exploring and coordinating networks and partnerships. Conducts community-based research to inform interventions, aligned to relevant legal and regulatory frameworks. Plans, designs and manages community interventions through the application of appropriate leadership and management styles; all of which are done to promote ethical and professional community development practice.

Community Development Worker ID 97708 Level 4

The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a learner to operate as a Community Development Worker.

A Community Development Worker collects and provides relevant information from and to communities and builds social cohesion within the community, to support the development and implementation of community development initiatives and processes.

A qualified learner will be able to:

Collect relevant community information and provide communities with accurate information relevant to their community development initiatives.

Operate effectively in groups, teams and forums and act ethically and professionally in data collection and the coordination of forums and meetings.

Communicate the fears, concerns and needs of the community effectively to the relevant institutions, structures and forums.

Compile integrated community and household profiles.

Health Promotion Officer ID 94597 Level 3

The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a learner to:

Carry out basic assessments of communities, households' groups and individuals.

Provide basic health education and referrals for a wide range of services.

Support and assist in navigating the health and social services system.

Homebase Personal Care Assistant ID 104779 Level 2

The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a learner to operate as a Home-Based Carer. Home Based Carers provide supervised care and support to patients and their immediate families/household members in the home and appropriate community-based settings to promote, restore and maintain a person's maximum level of comfort, function and health including care towards a dignified death.

Homebase Personal Care Worker ID 104792 Level 3

Home Based Carers provide supervised care and support to patients and their immediate families/household members in the home and appropriate community based settings in order to promote, restore and maintain a persons maximum level of comfort, function and health including care towards a dignified death. This qualification will equip learners with the necessary skills and competence to operate as Home-Based Carers.

Religious Associate Professional ID 101997 Level 2

The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a learner to operate as a Christian Religious Practitioner.

A Christian Religious Practitioner facilitates the effective practice of ministry work within a specific congregation/faith community to encourage spiritual formation, to nurture fellowship and mutual care within the congregation/faith community, to help members developing a Christian lifestyle, to provide Christian leadership, to ensure organisational well-being, and to facilitate appropriate responses of the congregation/faith community to needs in the wider society.

Christian Religious Professional ID 101571 Level 5

The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a learner to operate as a Christian Religious Professional.

A Christian Religious Professional directs and conducts the ministry functions in a faith community in order to facilitate spiritual formation; nurture fellowship and mutual care within the faith community; helps members to develop a Christian lifestyle; provides strategic leadership that leads to obedience to vocation as well as well-being and sustainability of the faith community; and develops a missional practice that shares the good news of Jesus Christ and serves the holistic well-being of the entire community.

Social Counselling Support Worker ID 111143 Level 4

The Occupational Certificate: Social Counselling Support Worker is part of the Occupational Certificate: Social Counselling Worker registered at National Qualifications Framework (NQF) Level 5. The purpose of this qualification is to provide the learner with the required knowledge, practical skills and workplace-based experience to operate as a Social Counselling Support Worker. A Social Counselling Support Worker offers supportive counselling functions to individuals, raise awareness of their services and refer individuals to appropriate services.

Social Counselling Worker ID 111142 Level 5

The purpose of this qualification is to provide the required knowledge, practical skills and workplace-based experience to prepare a learner to operate as a Social Counselling Worker. A Social Counselling Worker provides supportive counselling services to individuals, families, groups and/or communities within various contexts.

Child and Youth Care Worker ID 99510**Level 5**

A Child and Youth Care Worker contributes to the provision of holistic therapeutic care and supports the development of children and youth in order to ensure the appropriate development of the individuals through the application of professional life space interventions.

Aux Community Development Facilitator ID 210601**Level 5**

Auxiliary Community Development Facilitator certification aids in the delivery of social services and support to individuals, families, groups, and communities on a wide range of social services and related social welfare issues. Emotional trauma, emotional stress, financial stress, recreational requirements, social needs, and housing issues are among the services provided.

Basic Emergency First Aid Responder**ID 230801****Level 2**

The skills, values and knowledge reflected in this unit standard are required by people in the field of manufacturing and engineering.

The learning outcomes in this unit standard also contribute to the exit level outcomes required for various manufacturing and engineering qualifications.

Qualifying learners can perform basic first aid at the scene of an accident to minimise the risk of further injury or death.

Intermediate Emergency First Aid Responder**ID 230802****Level 3**

The level 3 first aid course is an advanced first aid course, the highest first aid level that can be achieved. It is recommended that all workplace supervisors, people with hazardous occupations, and people without easy access to healthcare services attend training on level 3 first aid.

This unit standard is to enable the first responder to react to emergencies at an advanced first aid level, until the arrival of more professional emergency personnel.
